PORSCHE 911 GT3 RS

The Porsche 911 GT3 RS is about as track-focused as a road car gets. The clue to its intended use is in the outlandish styling, but that aero isn't just for show — it's all there for a purpose. This includes the huge rear wing and snorting bonnet nostrils, while the underbody is fully panelled, with fins to better direct the airflow through and under the car. All of this trickery adds up to 860kg of downforce at 184mph.

Distinctive 22-inch alloy wheels and a magnificently opulent 'Double Diamond' grille mark the Continental Mulliner out from its already imposing stablemates. There are V8-flavoured versions but if it's top-of-the-line lavishness you want (and you probably do), then the twin-turbo W12 will be the one for you — and that's distinguished by thumping twin exhaust pipes rather than the quad tailpipes of 'lesser' V8 Mulliners.

MCLAREN 750S

The McLaren 750S is an evolution of the company's 730S rather than an all-new model, but the supercar maker says that 30 per cent of the car is new, and that includes a larger active rear wing, a new high-mounted exhaust, optional wheels that save 13.9kg of weight, an engine that develops 30bhp more thanks to higher boost pressure, and uprated suspension and steering. The result? A 200mph McLaren supercar that's even more super.

BMW M3 CS

Considering its pretty punchy price tag (in excess of £30,000 more than a 'regular' M3), the M3 CS doesn't exactly deliver on the 'bang per buck' scale. There's also a pair of racing stripes daubed prominently on the bodywork, just to remind you that this is one seriously special car.

ROLLS-ROYCE SPECTRE

If there's one brand that suits electrification, it's Rolls-Royce. Effortless power and near-silent progress? Sounds very on-brand for a bearer of the famous Spirit of Ecstasy. The Spectre uses the same aluminium spaceframe as the Phantom, Ghost and Cullinan, but instead of a creamy V12, the Spectre is powered by twin electric motors. It's not light either: courtesy in part of a 102kWh battery, it tips the scales at a hefty 2890kg.
